Decision No. 219/2024
of the Rector of the Warsaw University of Technology
of 2.10.2024

on the announcement of a competition for scripts for a short popular science film

Pursuant to Article 23 section 1, in connection with Article 389 sections 1 and 2 of the Act of 20 July 2018 - Law on Higher Education and Science (Journal of Laws of 2023, item 742, as amended) and in connection with Agreement No. 04/IDUB/2019/94 of 30 December 2019 concluded between the State Treasury represented by the Minister of Science and Higher Education and Warsaw University of Technology, it is resolved as follows:

§ 1

1. A competition for scripts for a short popular science film is announced. The competition aims to popularise research conducted at the Warsaw University of Technology.
2. The initiative mentioned in section 1 is financed from the funds of the “Excellence Initiative – Research University” programme.

§ 2

1. The subject of the competition is to prepare a draft script for a short popular science film (up to three minutes long) that the applicant wishes to produce. The topic of the film should be the research conducted at the Warsaw University of Technology or the research infrastructure available at the University.
2. The draft script should include a brief description of the research being conducted or the research infrastructure, an outline of the idea for the film, a description of the scenes, the dialogue, and the content of the off-screen narrative text.
3. The submitted script draft must be the applicant's original creation from start to finish, must be free of legal defects, and must not be encumbered by rights established in favour of third parties.
4. The prize in the competition is the production of a video based on the script draft submitted to the competition. The prize includes expert support in writing the unalterable version of the script, filming by a professional cameraperson, editing, and publication on the YouTube channel of the Warsaw University of Technology.
5. The applicant may be a student who is a member of a student research group, a doctoral student, or an employee who conducts research activities at the Warsaw University of Technology.
6. The applicant shall transfer free of charge the proprietary copyrights to the draft script to the Warsaw University of Technology as of the date of submission of the application to the competition.
7. The budget of the competition for 2024-2025 is PLN 60,000 and is intended for the recording and post-production of the film.

§ 3

1. The call for applications as part of the competition shall be conducted on a continuous basis until the funds are fully exhausted, but no later than 2 June 2025.
2. An applicant may submit only one application.
3. The application, prepared in accordance with the template set out in Annex No. 1 to the Decision, shall be submitted electronically using the online form available on the website www.badawcza.pw.edu.pl.

§ 4

1. The Committee shall evaluate and give its opinion on the application, according to the template attached as Annex No. 2 to the Decision, within no more than 15 working days of receipt of the application.
2. Applications for funding shall be evaluated by a competition committee consisting of:
 - 1) Dariusz Aksamit, MSc – chairperson
 - 2) Kamil Nowelli, MA
 - 3) Daria Grzesiek, MA
 - 4) Agnieszka Kapela, MA
 - 5) Rafał Wróblewski, PhD
3. The criteria for the evaluation of the application are:
 - 1) The attractiveness of the script topic
 - 2) The attractiveness and inventiveness of the presentation of the topic of the film in the script
 - 3) The possibility of realising the script
4. The Committee evaluates the application and forwards its opinion to the IDUB Project Office for approval by the Head of the Management Team for the IDUB Project. The Head of the Management Team for the IDUB Project shall determine the list of award winners based on the evaluation of the Selection Committee. The list of successful candidates is published on the website www.badawcza.pw.edu.pl.
5. The decision of the Head of the Management Team for the IDUB Project to determine the list of winners may be appealed in writing by the participant to the Vice-Rector for Development within 7 days of the announcement of the results on badawcza.pw.edu.pl. The decision of the Vice-Rector for Development is conclusive.

§ 5

The maximum date for completion of the recording with publication on the YouTube channel of the Warsaw University of Technology is established as 19 December 2025.

§ 6

The Decision enters into force upon signing.

Pursuant to Article 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (Journal of Laws of the EU L 119/1 of 4 May 2016), hereinafter referred to as “GDPR”, the Warsaw University of Technology hereby informs that:

1. The Administrator of your data is the Warsaw University of Technology with its registered seat at pl. Politechniki 1, 00-661 Warszawa.
2. The Administrator has appointed a Data Protection Officer (IOD) in his/her field to supervise the correctness of data processing. He or she can be contacted at the following e-mail address: iod@pw.edu.pl.
3. The Administrator will process the following personal data: first name, surname, academic degree/title, position, faculty.
4. Your personal data will be processed by the Administrator in order to realise the competition for scripts for short popular science films - the basis for processing your personal data is Article 6 section 1 point f) of GDPR.
5. The Warsaw University of Technology has no intention of transferring your data outside the European Economic Area.
6. You have the right of access to the content of your personal data and the right of correction, the right to request deletion, restriction of processing, and the right to object to the processing of your data. Since the prerequisite for the processing of personal data is not consent, you do not have the right to data portability.
7. Your personal data will not be made available to other entities (administrators), except for entities authorised based on the law.
8. Your personal data may be accessed by entities (processing entities) to whom the Warsaw University of Technology subcontracts activities that may involve the processing of personal data.
9. The Warsaw University of Technology shall not use automated decision-making in relation to you, including profiling.
10. The provision of your personal data is voluntary; however, failure to do so will prevent you from participating in the competition for scripts for short popular science footage as part of IDUB competitions.
11. Your personal data will be processed for the period indispensable to secure any possible claims.
12. You have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority - the Polish Data Protection Commissioner - if you consider that the processing of your personal data violates the provisions of the GDPR.
